- 1. Embed a metacognitive thinking culture throughout the curriculum to develop our pupils as independent learners through our use of 'Thinking Crowns'.
- **2.** Support teaching staff to make the best use of one-to-one devices in their lessons; stage one of our <u>Innovation Three-Year Plan.</u>
- 3. Continue to develop our Outdoor Learning Programme, gain a Gold Eco Schools Award and action further environmental improvement opportunities.
- **4.** Develop the talent programme 'Queen's Colours', recognising pupil talent in specialist subjects from Form I upwards.
- **5.** Continue to create a culture of wellbeing for both staff and pupils via our work culture, pupil expectations, our curriculum, and an established therapies and counselling service.

- 6. Further develop the new House system to incorporate it across the curriculum while offering more opportunities for competitive endeavours and teamwork.
- 7. Develop the Pupil Leadership Programme across the school, including more targeted roles for prefects.
- 8. Continue to develop partnerships and outreach to enhance the QCPS offering, including professional development, and supporting the Parent Charity Committee to improve our outreach provision.
