

Queen's College Preparatory School Uniform Guide

All QCPS school uniform (except where indicated on the list) must be purchased from our supplier, Stevensons, at: www.stevensons.co.uk. There is also an easy-to-use sizing guide available on their website. Please ensure that every item is labelled with your daughter's name and surname.

At the start of the academic year, girls may wear summer or winter uniform until the Michaelmas half term holiday. All girls must wear winter uniform when they return to school after the Michaelmas half term break. Summer uniform must be worn from the start of the Summer Term.

Winter Uniform

All Girls

- QCPS navy winter coat
- Navy felt hat with bottle green ribbon
- Navy & green winter bobble hat
- Scarf fleece-backed with Gordon tartan (optional)
- Navy blue tights or long navy socks
- Art/science/technology overall. Long-sleeved, nylon, navy with a front "velcro" fastening
- Navy Muddy Puddles waterproof jacket
- Navy fleece (optional)

Reception, Form I and Form II

- White rollneck cotton long-sleeved top
- Pinafore dress or Culottes
- QCPS navy trim cardigan
- QCPS blue rucksack
- Navy Muddy Puddles Bib and Brace waterproof trousers

Forms III, IV, V and VI

- White blouse with revere collar and long sleeves
- Skirt or Culottes
- QCPS navy trim V neck jumper
- Navy blazer jacket with green piping and crested lapel
- QCPS green rucksack

Summer Uniform

All girls

- Summer dress or Culottes with white blouse with revere collar and long sleeves
- Plain white cotton ankle socks with plain turnover
- QCPS boater
- QCPS white baseball cap
- Navy blazer jacket with green piping and crested lapel

- Navy QCPS hoodie top
- Navy training pants
- Navy short sleeved polo shirt
- Navy climaskin baselayer crested top
- Navy climaskin baselayer crested leggings
- Navy PE skort
- White sports socks

Forms III, IV, V and VI

- Navy QCPS hoodie top
- Navy training pants
- Navy short sleeved polo shirt
- Navy PE skort
- Navy climaskin baselayer crested top
- Navy climaskin baselayer crested leggings
- Navy hockey socks with white turnover
- QCPS swim cap
- Black or Navy swimming costume
- Hockey mouth guard (dentist fit recommended)
- Navy crested games bag

All girls

- White, black or navy trainers to be worn for PE (velcro fastening for Reception)
- House t-shirt
- Summer PE t-shirt

Additional sports kit, e.g. football boots etc., will be advised by individual year group

Hoodies and Sun Hats

Please note that the school hoodie should only be worn as part of the PE uniform. Similarly the white baseball hat is only worn for the Garden and for outside PE sessions. The boater is the official summer hat and should be worn by all girls to and from school, unless they are travelling in their PE kit.

Parents are asked to ensure that all items of clothing are **clearly marked** with the child's name. **All items must be clearly named**. **The School can take no responsibility for lost or missing items**.

Ballet & Dance

Reception

• Pink unblocked leather ballet shoes (Bloch or Capezio only)

Forms I, II and III (These items are mandatory for candidates for IDTA examinations)

- Pink unblocked leather ballet shoes (Bloch or Capezio only)
- IDTA royal blue skirted leotard
- White ballet socks
- Sky blue cardigan

All girls require a shoe bag (own choice of colour) specifically for ballet clothing.

Forms IV, V and VI

- Leotard, sleeveless lycra, black
- Plain black full-leg leggings
- Black Bloch Neo Flex Jazz shoes

Footwear

All girls

Shoes - plain dark blue or black "Start-Rite" type, flat heel, strap or T-bar style

Reception, Forms I and II

Wellington boots (to be left in school)

Hair, Nails and Jewellery

- Girls with long hair should wear hair bands, slides or scrunchies to keep hair tidy and off the face. These should be dark blue, dark green or tortoiseshell
- No make-up, nail polish or jewellery of any kind should be worn, including earrings. Where earrings are worn for religious reasons, the child should be able to remove them for PE lessons. Staff cannot assist with this.

Note: permission must be requested from the Headmistress for any other jewellery to be worn for cultural or religious purposes.
